The Kangaroo design is from Crawford's *Life in Line* 1970 art series in oils. The designer is an Australian – so much so that he is scared to stop still in case his toe grows roots and he turns into a gum tree.

The Union Jack ceased to exist in 1920 when Ireland and its cross left the union. Thus the Union Jack became a misleading entity. The Flag of Unity is inclusive – it welcomes all nations. A flag that says 'G'day' and looks like we mean it.

The flag's keyword is: 'Foreward'.
